



The Arnold Monthly Draw

What is the Arnold Monthly Draw (AMD)?

The AMD is run exclusively by the Parents' and Friends' Association to provide the Arnold community with an opportunity to win cash prizes and at the same time support Arnold pupils. This fundraising activity centres upon the purchase of numbers entered into a monthly draw, from which 7 numbers are selected. The lucky winners share half the AMD's income for that month and the remaining income is donated to fund school projects at the discretion of the Association. The more members we have, the greater the prize money and the greater the benefit to pupils and the school.

A single number costs a member £2.00 per month. Membership of the AMD is for a minimum period of twelve months and so the annual outlay could be as little as £24.00 giving the purchaser twelve opportunities to win. The value of the prizes will vary with the numbers in play each month. For example, if there are 1000 numbers in play there will be a £500, a £250 and five £50 prizes every month and £1000 will be donated to the school. There is no maximum quantity of numbers an individual can purchase and members may continue in the club even after their children have left the school.

Rules of the Arnold Monthly Draw

- Membership is open to current and former Arnold parents, staff, and their families, other than those administering the draw. There is a lower age limit of 18 years.
- The AMD will operate with an expected minimum of 200 numbers.
- There is no limit on the quantity of numbers permitted, additional numbers may be purchased at any time.
- Members may join at any time. There is a 12 month minimum period of involvement.
- Purchase is by standing order only, paid at the start of each month.
- Each number costs £2.00 per month, resulting in a payment of £24.00 per year per number. Members retain the same number/s for the duration of their involvement.
- Should payment lapse the individual's numbers will be withdrawn from the draw and may be reallocated to new members.
- The amount of money available for prizes will be equal to half the amount received during that month. The amount of money awarded to the seven prize winners will therefore fluctuate each month, the following is an illustration
 - A monthly draw containing 1000 numbers results in 1st Prize - £500, 2nd Prize - £250, 3rd Prize – 5 x £50.
 - A monthly draw containing 500 numbers results in 1st Prize - £250, 2nd Prize - £125, 3rd Prize – 5 x £25.
 - A monthly draw containing 200 numbers results in 1st Prize - £100, 2nd Prize - £50, 3rd Prize – 5 x £10.
- The amount of money available for good causes will be equal to half the amount received during that month and will be distributed as a donation by the Parents' and Friends' committee to good causes throughout the school. A list of beneficiaries will be published on a regular basis.
- The draw will take place on the last Friday of every month (wherever possible) including school holiday periods and will be made by a member of the School Management Team in the company of two members of the Parents' and Friends' Association who are not connected with the administration of the AMD; their decision is final. Winning numbers are drawn descending order of prize value, ie the first number drawn will be the 1st Prize.
- Prize money will be presented in the form of a cheque.
- Results will be published on the website in the week following the draw.
- The AMD will operate a dedicated bank account and detailed records of all transactions will be maintained – *and audited*.
